This webinar is intended for companies wanting to learn more about U.S. investments in infrastructure, healthcare, and environmental projects.

To help accelerate the recovery from the economic and health impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.S. Federal Government is providing trillions of dollars of stimulus funding. These funds will be distributed through two significant programs. The first, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), is a \$1.9 trillion economic stimulus bill that includes billions in discretionary dollars. The second, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), is the single largest investment by the Federal government in U.S. infrastructure, with \$1.2 trillion in funding.

This webinar will present both stimulus packages, the relevant areas of funding and spending goals, the direct economic impact, and provide recommendations for German companies selling to the United States market, including best practices
