The objective is to advocate for policies, legislation & practices that promote the development of accessible, quality, equitable and affordable health services and systems within the EAC region.
- 2. Institutional Development for strengthening and building capacity for EAHP members and partners. The objective is to ensure effective coordination of PSOs, CSOs and FBOs and programme delivery.

ABOUT THE EAST AFRICAN HEALTH PLATFORM

East African Health Platform (EAHP) is an advocacy forum for Private Sector Organizations (PSOs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), Faith Based Organizations (FBOs) and other interest groups working on health in East Africa. It was founded in 2012 subsequent to the approval of the dialogue framework between PSOs. CSOs and the East African Community (EAC). The Platform's formation was also based on the recognition of the importance of the public private partnership (PPPs) between the private sector. civil society, faith based organizations and government in promoting facilitative health related policy, law and practice for the benefit of the residents of the region. Its mandate is derived from article 118, 127,128 and 129 of the Treaty for the Establishment of the EAC to provide the space, be the voice and representative of PSOs, CSOs, FBOs and other Interest Groups of East Africa to effectively drive sustainable health, development and growth in the region.

Consequent to several consultations with the various health sector platforms, stakeholders and development Partners in the region, East African Business Council (EABC) and the East African Civil Society Organizations' Forum (EACSOF) with the financial support from EAC-GIZ GOPA initiated a joint action towards the establishment of the East African Health Platform comprising of the private sector, civil society organizations, Faith Based Organizations and Other Interest Groups to facilitate engagement and advocacy with the EAC Secretariat, Organs, Institutions and Partner States on health policies and legislation. The Platform was launched in March 2013 in Kigali, Rwanda by Hon. Jessica Osuna Eriyo, Deputy Secretary General. Productive and Social Sectors. EAC.

PLATFORM'S STRUCTURE

The General Assembly

The General Assembly is the highest structure of the Platform, and shall be composed of all the members of the Platform. The General Assembly considers and adopts policies, considers and determines applications for membership, discuss and approve annual plans and budgets, elect the Steering Committees, considers and determine proposals for membership fees and annual subscription rates, appoint auditors, approves the annual activities report, the annual financial statement and the annual audit report. The general meetings shall be held on a rotational basis in each of the five Partner States countries of the East African Community.

Steering Committee

The Steering Committee comprised of 10 member organizations composed of Private Sector Organizations (PSOs), Civil Society organizations (CSOs) and Faith Based Organizations (FBOs) elected from the General Assembly. The Steering Committee sits on a regular basis to guide the Platform's strategic direction, formulate policies & procedures, and approve budgets and review reports. The Executive Committee of the Steering Committee is composed of the Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary with the Coordinator sitting in as an **ex officio** member.

Membershi

Membership of the East African Health Platform is open to Private Sector Organizations (PSOs), Pharmaceutical & Manufacturing Organizations, Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) working on health, Faith Based Organizations (FBOs) and Other Interest Groups that subscribe to the mission and vision of EAHP and those that may qualify to be members as per the provision of EAHP membership guideline.

The Secretaria

The Secretariat is the coordinating unit of EAHP. It is headed by the Coordinator. The Secretariat carries out the daily operation and implementation of the EAHP programmes, interprets and spearheads implementation of the strategic plan, coordinates and facilitates members engagement on policy and legislative processes, spearheads and coordinates resource mobilization, capacity building to PSOs, CSOs, FBOs and Other Interest Groups to effectively respond to the policy and legislative processes with direct impact on health in the region.
